Be encouraged. In a recent visit with a confirmation class at Castleton UMC, I was reminded how the church is an instrument of God's grace and a place for discipleship growth. When we meet in groups including 7th and 8th graders, we can see glory sightings of discipleship incubators. When asked, "What do bishops do?" I responded to the students with, "encouragement." Though my encouragement was a reminder that God speaks to us through the Bible with a consistent message, "you are loved."

As much as your family loves you, your church loves you, God loves you. God loves us with an "everlasting love." (*The Lord spoke to me again. – Jeremiah 31:3 CEB*)
